1 Begin

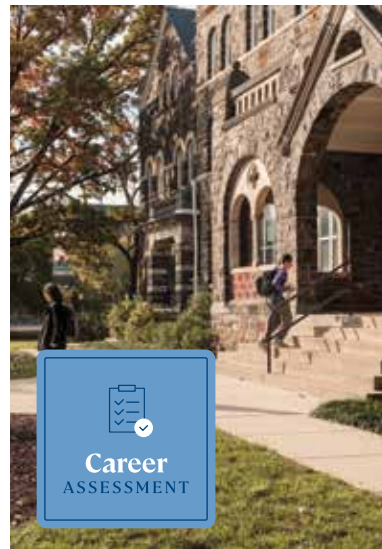
YEAR a new journey

During your first year at Moravian, Elevate will introduce you to the college experience. You'll learn about the four areas of focus that will guide your studies and extracurricular pursuits. These include Teamwork and Leadership, Global Experience, Work Experience, and Career Support.

Before you even begin classes, you'll receive your new Apple MacBook Pro and iPad and participate in our career assessment and personality survey. This will lead directly into your experience at New Student Orientation, where you'll connect with your advising team, including your academic advisor and career strategist, for the first time. They'll be with you throughout your four years at Moravian and beyond!

This year is all about getting acclimated and transitioning from high school to college. You're encouraged to get involved with our student organizations and sports teams, get comfortable with your Apple technology, attend lectures and workshops happening on campus, and take classes that push you out of your comfort zone. These activities will earn you points toward your Bronze Career Readiness Badges!

By the end of your first year, you'll have the lay of the land and a good idea of what to expect from the Elevate experience over the next few years.



2 Explore

YEAR your options

Your sophomore year is when your academic pursuits and goals will come into focus—but not before you've explored all your options and passions! In collaboration with your advising team, you'll officially declare your major and begin considering how you'd like to shape the rest of your Elevate experience at Moravian.

This is the perfect time for a study abroad opportunity, or, as we like to call it, your "Global Greyhound Trip." Your Elevate experience includes a faculty-led trip to one of our featured destinations—the Czech Republic or Costa Rica—at no extra cost to you! Moravian's Center for Global Education can provide more information about the timing and logistics.

Other opportunities that you might consider looking into include the RISE Teamwork and Leadership Program, Peace Corps Prep Program, Fellowship and Scholarship Advising, Student Opportunities for Academic Research (SOAR), and more. Your advising team will point you in the right direction toward the opportunities that will best support your career pursuits and earn you points toward your Silver Career Readiness Badges.



3 Immerse

YEAR yourself in the experience

This year, dive deeper into the academics of your chosen major. You'll be fully immersed in the curriculum and connected with your peers and faculty in your academic department.

Now is the time to really put your coursework to use. During your junior year, you'll work with your advising team to gain the hands-on experiences and leadership skills employers and graduate schools are looking for. This could include landing an internship with one of our community partners, pursuing a research project with a faculty member, logging clinical hours at a health network, or volunteering in our local school district. The Center for Career and Civic Engagement and your advising team are ready to help you find the perfect fit!

You'll also check in with your advising team to make sure you're on track to graduate and begin thinking about what you want to do with your degree. Is graduate school in your future, or will you enter the workforce? Year 3 provides opportunities to attend networking events and take on leadership opportunities to earn points toward your Gold Career Readiness Badges.



4 Prepare

YEAR for what's next

Your final year at Moravian is the culmination of all your hard work—this is your time to shine.

So take advantage of the leadership opportunities in your clubs and organizations, participate in the Honors Program, enroll in a capstone course, or pursue another global travel opportunity. When graduation arrives, you'll be well equipped to begin your career or continue your education in a graduate program.
