COOPERATIVE AND DUAL DEGREE PROGRAMS

Lehigh University

P.C. Rossin College of Engineering and Applied Science

Earn a BS in physics from Moravian College and an MS in mechanical engineering or mechanics from Lehigh University with an average total of 5½ years of full-time study.

Penn State Health *Milton S. Hershey Medical Center*

The Medical Laboratory Science Program is an 11-month training program that will result in a certificate in medical laboratory science from Penn State Health Milton S. Hershey Medical Center while fulfilling requirements for a bachelor's level degree in a medical laboratory science–related major from Moravian College.

Washington University in St. Louis McKelvey School of Engineering

Qualified students have the opportunity to earn a BA in physics from Moravian College and a BS in engineering from WashU in a total of 5 years.

Temple University Lewis Katz School of Medicine

Moravian College participates in the Lewis Katz School of Medicine's Early Assurance Program, a unique program that allows Moravian graduates (once they are accepted to the Lewis Katz School of Medicine) to complete their 4 years of medical school at St. Luke's University Health Network in Bethlehem.

Graduate and Continuing Studies

Earn your bachelor's and business master's degrees from Moravian College in as little as 5 years. Take graduate-level courses during your senior year to help you transition into a full, final year of graduate studies.

Widener University Delaware Law School

Complete both a bachelor's degree and a graduate law degree (Juris Doctor) in 6 years by enrolling at Widener University's Delaware Law School after your junior year at Moravian College. If admitted to Widener, you will receive a \$10,000-per-year scholarship.

Rutgers Law School

Complete both a bachelor's degree and a graduate law degree (Juris Doctor) in 6 years by enrolling at Rutgers Law after your junior year at Moravian College.

Widener University Delaware Law School

Through Widener's Express or Guaranteed Admission Program, qualified Moravian graduates will be admitted to Delaware Law and receive a \$10,000-per-year scholarship.


We'll Provide the Technology

In fact, we highly encourage you to get off campus for an internship, externship, or co-op! The Center for Career and Civic Engagement can help you find the perfect fit.

Internships

Internships are carefully monitored work or volunteer experiences in which you have intentional learning goals. You can intern in almost any area of study in any part of the country or abroad.

Externships

Externships connect you with a professional in your area of interest. You'll experience the industry firsthand through short-term job shadowing and employer site visits, so you can make an educated decision when choosing a major and seeking employment after graduation.

Co-ops

Co-ops are similar to internships but are typically more intensive. You participate full-time (36 to 40 hours per week) while enrolled in one course connected to your co-op experience.

Alternative Break Service Trips

Service trips allow students to gain a greater understanding of global political, social, and economic issues while visiting different parts of the United States and the world. Through training, orientation, and guided reflection, students embark on self-discovery and personal transformation.

The 1742 Experience

The 1742 Experience offers an opportunity, before first-year orientation, for students to focus on service in the community. This hands-on learning program brings students to campus one week early to build relationships with classmates and to develop a commitment to service and leadership for the common good.

Heritage Day

Heritage Day is a celebration of Moravian tradition, community, and service. For one day during the fall semester, classes are canceled and students, faculty, and staff gather to serve their community. Office for Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion



The Blue and Grey


Did you know Moravian College adopted the colors blue and grey in 1894? With the bitter battles of the American Civil War still a recent memory, the choice of colors represented a gesture of unity and healing.

The Moravian Mile

The distance between North and South campuses is known as the "Moravian Mile." As part of orientation, first-year students walk the Mile between campuses, traveling from North to South through Historic Bethlehem on their way. Once their time at Moravian College is complete, graduating seniors take part in the "Backwards Walk," walking the Moravian Mile as they did in their freshman year, but this time in reverse.

Vespers

A local holiday tradition hosted by Moravian College, Christmas Vespers is a beautiful service that features two forms of Moravian worship, the "Singstunde" and the Candlelight Service. Music by our students combines with the beauty of the liturgy in this service of worship for the college community and friends.

Application Requirements

Moravian accepts both the Common Application and the Moravian College Application. Wondering which to use? Both applications have the same requirements, so you can choose whichever is easier for you. The best part— Moravian College has no application fee!

In addition to a completed application, you are required to submit the following:

- Official high school transcripts
- Official SAT or ACT scores (optional for non-nursing students)
- Teacher or Counselor Recommendation

Test-Optional Policy

The submission of SAT and ACT standardized test scores is optional for students applying for undergraduate admission (with the exception of students applying to the nursing program). Scores will still be accepted and considered if the applicant desires.

If you choose not to submit test scores, it will not hurt your application. Test scores are not required in order to be considered for most scholarships and financial aid.
